

YOUTH ACTIVITY LEADER (Part-time, contract)

The University Neighbourhoods Association (UNA) is a not-for-profit organization that provides municipallike services to approximately 15,000 residents who live in the University of British Columbia's Point Grey campus. The UNA offers recreational services such as arts, fitness, music, educational and social programs and events for all age groups at the Old Barn and Wesbrook Community Centres.

Under the general supervision of the Programming and Events, Youth Program Coordinator, the Youth Activity Leaders will assist in the development, coordination and delivery of Youth Programs at the UNA. There will be two Youth Activity Leaders who will each deliver one of UNA's hallmark programs: Pre-teen Leadership and Youth Leadership. This position will also facilitate youth drop-in programs and workshops to promote safety and inclusivity for youth in the community.

- Plan and deliver age-appropriate activities, workshops, field trips and events
- Develop positive relationships with participants and act as a role model and mentor to youth
- Assist with the participation of youth in community events, programming in community spaces, service projects within the community, and the promotion of youth activities
- Assist with the development of youth connections within the broader UBC community
- Maintain the cleanliness, general appearance, and good working condition of the youth programming office and programming space
- Assist with room set-up and clean up, as required, for programs, functions, and events
- Complete special projects and other duties as assigned
